

Theme: Reaffirmation of our Faith

(Joshua 1:8) This book of the Law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it by day and by night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall act wisely.

Purpose to walk in Faith and Obedience to God's word.

PURPOSE: Understand the reaffirmation of faith in prayer.

1. Kindly read Psalm 71

- a. Does the psalmist seem to be a youth or older?
 - i. What specific verse guides your answer in (a) above?
- b. What kind of prayer is Psalm 71?
- c. What is the psalmist reaffirming in verses 1-4?
- d. Do you think that we also need to reaffirm our confidence in God?
- e. What are the needs of the psalmist highlighted in this psalm?
- f. What fears of the psalmist are expressed in this psalm? See verses 9-13
 - i. Do the psalmist's fears tend to be similar to what we usually fear?
- 2. What is the psalmist communicating in verses 14-18?
- 3. What verses highlight the psalmist's new commitment in trusting the Lord?
- 4. What has the Lord taught you about faith that you can use to reaffirm your faith when you face challenging times?
 - a. How can you use those lessons in (4) above to encourage the younger generation?
- 5. What is the psalmist testifying of in verses 19-21?
- 6. What does the psalmist do in anticipation of God's help?
 - a. What do you think we should do when we anticipate God's help?
- 7. Take some time to reflect once more on those verses that identify with your current life experiences and pray.
