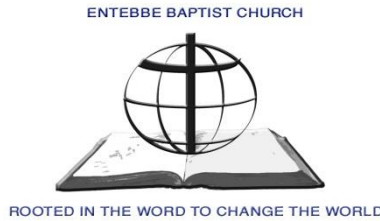

Bible Study Week 07-14 March 2021

Theme of the year: "Victory only through Faith and Obedience"

THEME: God's Divine Empowerment to Victory

(Joshua 1:8) This book of the Law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it by day and by night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall act wisely.

PURPOSE: To understand victory through King David's song of victory.

1. Kindly take some time this week to read **Psalm 18**.
 - a. What *key words* does the psalmist use to describe the Lord in verses 1-4?
 - b. Psalm 18 is a song of victory that was sang by David to the Lord.
 - i. Have you ever sang a song of victory to the Lord?
 - ii. What was the main theme of your song?
 - c. What is the psalmist reminding us to do in verses 4-6 when our lives are in danger?
 - i. What does calling on to the Lord mean to you?
 - d. The psalmist cried to the Lord in verse 6.
 - i. Do we really have to cry to the Lord in challenging times? Or Only trust Him.
 - e. How does God react to David's call and cry in verses 7-17?
 - i. Do you think God can use nature to fight on our behalf?
 - f. Do you believe that God can also act like that or much more on our behalf?
2. How do verses 20-26 encourage us to live?
 - a. Do you think that the psalmist in verse 26 means that God is shrewd (crooked)?
3. What kind of people does the Lord save according to the psalmist in verse 27?
4. How many verses communicate the psalmist's acknowledgement of God's empowerment?
 - a. How do you think God trains us to overcome our enemies in this dispensation (Day and time)?
5. We might not be like David on the front line fighting physical battles and also having a known enemy like Saul was to him, however what are the enemies of our souls do you battle with every day as highlighted in the word of God.
6. What key lessons have you learned from David's testimony as he sang it?
