

Bible Study Week13 -20 June 2021

Theme of the year: "Victory only through Faith and Obedience"

THEME: The Sovereign God Is Mighty to Save

PURPOSE: To be assured that the our sovereign God is mighty to save [Matthew 19:26 and Mark 10:27

- 1. Kindly read Daniel Chapter 2.
 - a. How do you describe the incidence in verses 8-12?
 - b. What does it mean to you that Daniel handled the situation with wisdom and discretion or prudence? [Verse 14-16]
 - i. Do you think we need wisdom when we are faced with a crisis? [In this case, it was death].
 - c. Why do you think Daniel went to God in prayer after being assured of king Nebuchadnezzar's decree? How do you handle the reality of crises in life?
 - i. What do we learn from Daniel urging his friends to ask God in prayer?
 - ii. Do you sense any panic in the life of Daniel?
 - iii. Why do you think sometimes we do not make prayer our first priority when we face a crisis?
 - iv. How does this speak to us during this critical season of Covid-19 pandemic?
 - d. God answered just in **ONE NIGHT**. What does that mean to you? [See verse 19]
 - e. What attributes and supernatural abilities of God does Daniel bring to our attention in praising God? See verses 20-23
- 2. How does Daniel describe God in verses 27-28?
 - a. Why do you think Daniel gave praise to God before He went to the king? Verse 19.
 - b. What lesson do we learn from Daniel in [a] above? What lesson do we learn from Daniel in verse 24?
- 3. Do you believe God can reveal to us all about the Covid-19 Pandemic?
- 4. How did Daniel honor God before the king in verse 27? In what ways do we fail to honor God when He answers our prayers?
- 5. What then came out of the crisis in verses 48-49? How does the end of this chapter encourage you during this season when many are afflicted with the Covid-Pandemic?
- 6. What other lessons do you learn from this text? How are you going to apply them in your life this week?
