

 - iv. What is Job cautious of in Job 31:4, 5?
 - v. How does Job 31:9-12 speak to us?
 - b. What criteria is Job using to examine himself with His walk with God?
 - i. What do verse Job 15-19 reflect of Job's character?
 - ii. What godly virtues are listed in Job 31:16-21
 - iii. What other things that can be compared to verse Job 31:24 that give us false hopes and secretly entice us?
- 2. In comparison to Job 31:30; Why do you think that godly people need to restrain their tongues?
 - a. What are the dangers of not restraining our tongues as godly people?
- 3. What key godly virtues from Job's life do you think the church might be lacking today?
- 4. What key lessons do we learn from Job chapter 31?
