

  - b) In what ways is Hebrews 11:32-35 encouraging us to persistently have faith in God?
- 3. Wednesday Reading and Reflection: II Chronicles 20:12, II Chronicles 32:7-8.
  - a) What do you learn from the characters in these scriptures?
  - b) How are these scriptures related to faith in God? Daniel 3:17, Acts 27:25
- 4. Thursday Reading and Reflection: Luke 7:1-9
  - a) What authority did the Centurion recognize in Jesus?
  - b) What do you think Luke meant with the expression "so great faith" in Luke 7:9?
  - c) How was faith rewarded in this passage?
- 5. Friday Reading and Reflection: Matthew 15:22-28
  - a) What lesson do we learn from this Canaanite woman?
  - b) In what ways do we need to continue trusting God even when those around us seem not to care?
- 6. Saturday Reading and Reflection: John 11:1-6, 14-23, 32-44.
  - a) Is divine delay a hindrance or a test of faith?
  - b) What does the John mean in John 11:4?
