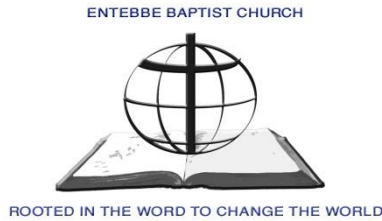

1. **Monday Reading and Reflection:** Leviticus 19:18 Mark 12:29, Romans 13:9.
  - a) What two relationships are highlighted in these scriptures?
  - b) What similar word defines these two relationships?
  - c) Who is your neighbor in view of these scriptures?
  - d) Do you think that we can genuinely love others without loving God?
2. **Tuesday Reading and Reflection:** John 10:25-37, John 5:30.
  - a) How do you describe the relationship between Jesus and the Father?
  - b) What do we learn from this passage?
3. **Wednesday Reading and Reflection:** Genesis 2:6,11.
  - a) What failed the relationship between God (Creator) and Man (Creation) in Genesis?
  - b) Do you think sin is still a problem in our relationships today?
4. **Thursday Reading and Reflection:** Matthew 7:1-5, Romans 2:1-4, James 4:11-12
  - a) Do these passages mean that we ignore sin?
  - b) How can we help others to overcome sinful acts and tendencies without judging, condemning, and criticizing them? Matthew 18:15-17, Luke 17:1-4, I Thessalonians 5:14, I Timothy 5:1-2
  - c) What lessons do we learn from these passages?
5. **Friday Reading and Reflection:** Luke 6:31, Matthew 7:12.
  - a) What do the authors of these scriptures mean?
  - b) In what ways should we treat others; as we would desire them treat us?
  - c) In what ways should we not treat others?
6. **Saturday Reading and Reflection:** Genesis 4:1-9.
  - a) What failed this brotherly relationship?
  - b) What lessons do we learn from this passage?
