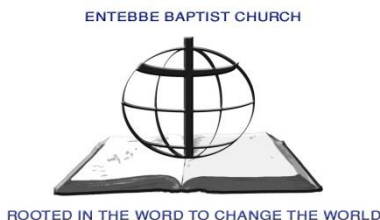

**Bible Study Week October [18 – 24] 2021**  
**Theme of the year: “Victory only through Faith and Obedience”**

**Theme: Obedience to the Great Commission**

**Purpose:** To understand and awaken the need to obey the great commission.

1. **First Reading:** Matthew 24:14, Isaiah 2:3, 29:18, 52:7, 61:1.
  - a) What do these prophecies highlight about the Gospel?
2. **Second Reading:** Read and reflect on Matthew 28:19-20 and Mark 16:15-16.
  - a) What specific steps apart from “GO”, are involved in this Christ’s program for missions?
  - b) Why do you think Christ commands us to go to all nations? See also Luke 19:10, 1 John 2:2.
  - c) How can we teach those who have been born again to obey everything God has commanded?
  - d) What does preaching or proclaiming the Gospel<sup>1</sup> mean to you according to the scriptures?
3. **Third Reading:** Romans 10:13-20.
  - a) What is this passage calling us to do?
  - b) Why do we really need to preach<sup>2</sup> the good news (the Gospel)? See also Mark 13:10.
  - c) When was the last time you sent yourself to preach the Gospel?
  - d) Do you think all Ugandans have heard the Gospel? Do all Ugandans understand the Gospel and have believed the true Gospel? See verses 18-19.
  - e) What is a false or another Gospel? Read II Corinthians 11:1-4, Galatians 1:6-9, Colossians 2:8, Jude 1:3-4.
  - f) In what ways is Uganda similar to Israel? See verse 20.
4. **Fourth Reading:** I Corinthians 15:1-8
  - a) What is the Gospel according to Apostle Paul?
  - b) What is the purpose of the Gospel? Read also Romans 1:16.
    - i. Do you think that today the church is ashamed of preaching the Gospel?
  - c) How is 2(b) related to Romans 1:16?
  - d) What do we need to effectively witness for Christ? See Acts 1:8.
  - e) What content of the Gospel is highlighted in Luke 24:47?
5. **Fifth Reading:** Matthew 4:23-25.
  - a) What does this text reveal about the preaching of the Gospel? See also I Thessalonians 1:4-5
  - b) What else did Jesus do when preaching the Gospel?
  - c) Do you believe we can also do what Jesus did after preaching the Gospel in this text?
6. **Sixth Reading:** Acts 20:24-25.
  - a) How does Apostle Paul call the Gospel in this text? Read also Ephesians 2:8-9.
7. **Seventh Reading:** Acts 2:28, 3:19, 8:22, 17:30, 26:20.
  - a) What common command of preaching the gospel is stated in these texts?
