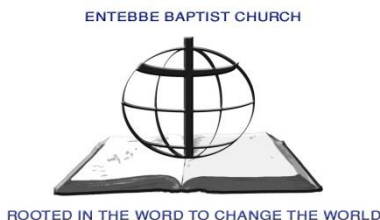

**Bible Study Week [February 27-06 March] 2022**  
**Theme of the year: "Fear God, Honor Him, Serve Him"**  
**Theme: Detestable things to God [Part II]**

**Our Theme for the Year 2022 is taken from Malachi 3:16-18** Then those who *feared the LORD* spoke with one another. The LORD paid attention and heard them, and a book of remembrance was written before him of those who feared the LORD and esteemed his name. "They shall be mine, says the LORD of hosts, in the day when I make up my treasured possession, and I will spare them as a man spares his son who serves him. Then once more you shall see the distinction between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve him.  
**May the Lord distinguish us this year for Reverencing Him, Honoring Him, and Serving Him faithfully.**

1. **Monday Reading and Reflection: Proverbs 6:18-19, Proverbs 12:22.**
  - a) What detestable things do these texts highlight?
  - b) In what ways do we speak lies to one another?
  - c) What things do we need to be careful of, that might sow discord among Brethren?
2. **Tuesday Reading and Reflection: Proverbs 15:8, 9, 26.**
  - a) Take time to note down detestable things to God highlighted in these texts.
  - b) What do the "**but's**" of these texts helps us to understand?
  - c) What does God delight in according to these texts above?
3. **Wednesday Reading and Reflection: Proverbs 16:5, Proverbs 17:15.**
  - a) What are the indicators of a proud heart?
  - b) How do we sometimes justify the wicked or wickedness?
4. **Thursday Reading and Reflection: Zechariah 8:16-17.**
  - a) What does the author highlight in this text?
  - b) How can we biblically deal with things that cause evil imaginations in our hearts?
5. **Friday Reading and Reflection: Malachi 2:14-16.**
  - a) How does this text speak to the church of Christ and married couples today?
  - b) What is God's expectation to the men according to this text?
6. **Saturday Reflections:** Kindly, take some time today to reflect on your study from Monday to Friday and how you will then respond towards detestable things to God.
